

Senior Off-Campus Privilege

(Must be on file in the school office prior to leaving campus.)

The “senior privilege” of being allowed to leave campus during normal school hours (8:30 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.) is a genuine privilege and not a “right” of seniors. The privilege can be lost if abused, or if grades reach unacceptable levels (as determined by the principal), or for any misconduct for which the principal determines a temporary or permanent loss of the privilege is indicated. Late return to the campus is a very serious breach of the privilege permit and will lead to loss of privilege

By agreeing to allow a student to enjoy this privilege, the parent signing this permission form, agrees to hold the school and all of its employees and directors harmless in the event of any mishap or accident that occurs during the permitted off-campus period.

The times of day that the privilege is permitted is determined by school policy and explained to the students; examples are lunch time and seventh hour study hall times.
