

## General Graduation Requirements

In order to graduate from Runnels School, students must meet the Louisiana Dept. of Education requirements for non-public schools (outlined in Nonpublic Bulletin 741: Chapter 21). In addition, please note that Runnels students are required to be enrolled in math every year, even if they have already met the graduation requirements. Students are also required to take physical science before enrolling in chemistry.

Each student must earn a minimum of 24 units including the following classes:

- English I or English I honors
- English II or English II honors
- English III, American Studies (Honors English), English III AP
- English IV or English IV AP
  
- Algebra I
- Geometry
- Algebra II
- Advanced Mathematics Pre-calculus or Advanced Mathematics Functions and Statistics
  
- Physical Science
- Biology or Biology honors
- Chemistry or Chemistry honors
- One of the following: Earth Science, Environmental Science, Environmental Science AP, Biology II, Biology AP, Chemistry AP, Physics, or Physics AP
  
- World Geography or Human Geography AP
- World History or World History AP
- American History, US History AP or American Studies (Honors History)
- Civics or US Government AP
  
- Health and PE (2 full units)
- Foreign Language (2 full units of the same language)
- Arts (1 full unit or 1 unit of Fine Arts Survey)
- Electives (3 full units)
